Are you an adult and need the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Eucharist?

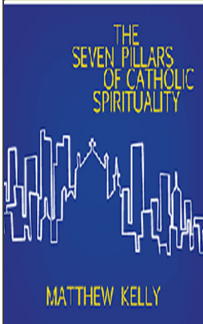
